



1. Secure Lower Bumper to Upper Bumper using four Carriage Bolts (M8 x 55 mm) and four Flange Nylon Nuts. Tighten securely. See Fig. 1.



Secure Left and Right Rubber Covers to the bumper assembly using four Button Head Screws (M5 x 40 mm) (B), two Button Head Screws (M5 x 45 mm) (A), six M5 Black Lock Washers, and six Custom Washers. Tighten to 10 in-lb. Do not overtighten. See Fig. 2.



3. Loosely secure Right and Left Upper Attachment Brackets with Right and Left U-Brackets around the rear vertical tubes making sure the brackets are orientated 90° with the frame tubes using four Carriage Bolts (M8 x 25 mm) and four M8 Flange Nylon Nuts. Finger tighten only at this time. See Fig. 3, 4 and 5.






4. Position the rear bumper assembly onto the vehicle and secure the bottom to the frame using two Button Head Screws (M8 x 25 mm), two M8 Black Washers, and two flange nylon nuts. Tighten securely. See Fig. 6.



5. Secure the rear bumper to the upper attachment brackets using two carriage bolts (M8 x 25 mm) and two flange nylon nuts. Tighten securely. See Fig. 7 and 8.
