




1. Remove the torx screws securing the cargo box to the rear facia; then remove the torx screw securing the rear left fender to the cargo box. See Fig. 1.




2. Position Left-Side Fender Flare with the mounting location and loosely secure using the torx screw from step 1. See Fig. 2.



- 3. Mark the two front mounting locations on bottom side of the left rear fender; then remove the flare. Using a 3/ 16-in. drill bit, drill both mounting locations.
- 4. Secure the flare to the rear facia and left rear fender using the torx screws from step 1 and two Button Head Screws, Fender Washers, and two Flange Nuts. Tighten securely. Repeat for opposite side. See Fig. 3.



■ NOTE: If Deluxe Rear Steel Bumper is installed, cut along the dotted line on the bottom side of the flare or use the attached templates. See Fig. 4.
