

Pre-installation: Lay out components and compare to list and images.

- Step 1: Place vehicle on a flat and level surface. Place in gear, engage parking brake and remove keys from the ignition.
- Important: It is recommended to install the DragonFire Harness Anchor (sold separately) and after-market harness restraints (sold separately) after removing the seats and before completing this installation.
- Step 2: Beginning with the driver side, use the seat adjuster to move the seat all the way forward. (Figure A)
- Step 3: Remove factory seat cushion and then remove factory bolts. (Figure B) Set bolts aside for later use.
- Step 4: Remove factory seat assembly from vehicle. (Figure C)



- Step 5: Install the Driver Outboard Bracket using factory bolts removed in Step 3. Ensure holes of the bracket are centered to holes of the seat adjuster. (Figure D) Ensure the slotted hole of the bracket is toward the rear of vehicle. The top flange of bracket should be facing toward the center console of vehicle.
- Step 6: Install the Driver Inboard Bracket using factory bolts. Ensure holes of the bracket are centered to holes of the seat adjuster. (Figure E) Ensure the slotted hole of the bracket is toward the rear of vehicle. The top flanges of brackets should be facing toward each other.

Step 7: Torque all 4 bolts to factory specifications. (Figure F)



Step 8: Locate the RT seat (sold separately) and remove the seat cushion. (Figure G)

- Step 9: Install 2 sets of supplied hardware to the holes toward the seat back. Leave a minimum gap of 1/8" between bolt and hole. Ensure the hardware is arranged in the following order: bolt (P4), lock washer (P5), and flat washer (P6). (Figure H)
- Step 10: Align the seat to brackets, place bolts into slots, and slide the seat back to set the seat in position. (Figure I)





Step 11: Align front holes of the seat to front holes of brackets and then install using supplied hardware. (Figure J)

Note: It is recommended to use a thin Allen wrench, dowel pin, or rod to align holes of seat to brackets before installing hardware.

Step 12: Torque all 4 bolts to 5 ft-lbs (60 in-lbs). (Figure K) Shake the seat to verify it is firmly set in position.

Step 13: Repeat steps 3 to 4 for passenger side.

Step 14: Install the passenger bracket to the vehicle frame using factory bolts. Ensure holes are centered. (Figure L) Ensure the placement of the slotted hole is toward the rear of vehicle. The top flange of bracket should be facing toward the outside of vehicle.



- Step 15: Repeat Step 14 for the second passenger bracket. Ensure top flanges of both brackets are facing the same direction. (Figure M) Torque all 4 bolts to factory specifications.
- Step 16: Repeat Step 8 to 12. (Figure N)
- Step 17: Slide the driver side seat back to desired position.
- Step 18: Place seat cushions back onto seats. Then route harness restraints through the cutout of the seat and install using the instructions of the harness manufacturer. (Figure O)



Step 19: This completes installation. Time to ride and enjoy!

ProTip: Periodically check all hardware and re-tighten if needed.
