Tools Required
Electric Drill
6 mm drill bit
10 mm wrench




Step 1: Place vehicle on a flat and level surface. Place gear selector in "Park" and remove keys from the ignition.

Step 2: (Not needed) but, if wiring a rocker switch, extra wire will be needed to run power to the bluetooth / remote control box if desired. Locate power source, connect (P1) wires to source, and connect to wire harness (P1). (Figure A).

Step 3: Locate desired location for wire harness

Step 4: Install the bluetooth box and route the wiring to the locations for mounting your lights. (Figure B). Make sure to hook up the red wire (+) and the black wire (-) ground to the correct power bar connection. The blue wire is the antenna for the remote (Do not hook up to power).

Step 5: Drill a hole for each light using .68" bit for the light, screw in place. Rotate the light the direction you want and screw in place with the screws and nuts provided. Do not over tighten. Over tightening will cause the screws to strip. Recommend putting thread locker on the screw to keep it from backing off. (Figure B).

Bluetooth and remote control instruction will be included on a sperate instruction form.

This completes installation. Time to ride and enjoy!



ProTip: Periodically check all hardware and re-tighten if needed.
