

Complete

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- 1 Using an 8mm socket remove the stock plastic deflector. (figure 1)
- 2 Position the front strap labeled 672-02 as shown. (figure 2)
- 3 Position the "hook shaped" rear clamp as shown. (figure 3 & 4)
 - a. Note: this clamp must be centered between the frame rails for ideal fitment.
- 4 Situate the skid plate against the bottom of the frame as shown. (figure 5)
- 5 Using the provided M8x25mm flat head bolts: attach the skid plate to the rear clamp. (figure 6)
 - a. Note: only finger tighten at this time.
- 6 Using the provided M8x40mm flat head bolts: attach the skid plate to the front strap. (figure 7)
- 7 Once all 4 bolts are in place; start tightening them while pressing skid plate up against the frame.
 - a. Note: alternate from front to back until the skid plate is secure.
