STEP 1

Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool. Remove main fuse.

STEP 2 Refer to PIC 2. Remove the left side cover to gain access to battery. and the seat if applicable.




STEP 3 Refer to PIC 3. Remove existing air cleaner assembly and hardware. Set it aside, it will not be reused. Ensure that the intake flange of the throttle body is clean and dry.



STEP 4 Locate and disconnect the motorcycle's ignition coil connector.


Note: Refer to your motorcycle's service manual for assistance.

STEP 5 Refer to PIC 4. Locate provided controller.



- STEP 6 Refer to PIC 5. Feed the controller's ignition coil connectors wire along the frame of the bike and over the cylinder heads.
- STEP 7 Refer to PIC 6. Connect the controller's ignition coil connectors (male and female) to the motorcycle's connectors that were disconnected in Step 4.

Note: The tank may have to be loosened and lifted in the front to gain access to the motorcycle's ignition coil connectors.

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#### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 9 Refer to PIC 9. Feed the controller's 3-pin connector wire through an open slot of the frame, under the seat area. Position the wire over the

top of the rear cylinder head and down and behind the throttle body. Do not tie these wires off to the frame or other cables just yet.



**STEP 10** Set the whole controller within a safe open space located in the frame under the left cover area.

> Note: The 6-pin connector, located on the opposite side from all of the other wires, does not connect to anything. It can be wrapped in electrical tape and tucked off to the side with the rest of the module.

**STEP 11** Refer to PIC 10 through 12. Locate provided Breather Manifold, Front Gasket, and Back Gasket. Align and place front gasket on the front of the breather manifold, and the back gasket on the back of the gasket. Be sure that the holes of the gasket align with, but do not cover, the three holes on the manifold.



- **STEP 13** On the front side of the Breather Manifold, press the O-rings into the indented circles located in each of the mounting holes of the Manifold.
- **STEP 14** Apply a small amount of blue Loctite to Breather Bolts. Insert the Breather Bolts through the Manifold. Ensure the bolts capture
- **STEP 15** On the back side of the Breather Manifold, place the Rubber Coated Washers over the end of the Bolts.
- **STEP 16** Refer to PIC 14 through 16. Align and fasten the Breather Manifold assembly to the cylinder heads with the Breather Bolts; ensure the O-rings remain in place.

Determine if additional Rubber Coated Washers are necessary to take up any remaining space between the breather legs and cylinder heads. If none are necessary skip to STEP 17.

Carefully remove the Breather Bolts; add Washers as required. Again, ensure that the O-Rings and Gasket remain in place; tighten the Breather Bolts.

Note: Make sure the controller's 3-pin connector wire is position behind the installed Breather Manifold.

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
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**STEP 17** 

Refer to FIG 1. Locate the provided Hypercharger ES Air Cleaner assembly. Dismantle the air cleaner assembly. Make note as to how it is assembled, it will help for reassembly.

- Remove two (2) outside edge screws from cone, and loosen the two (2) inside edge screws
- Remove the cover by pushing it to the left
- Remove two (2) screws and two (2) washers attaching the air filter
- Remove air filter from backer plate assembly



**STEP 18** 


Refer to PIC 17. Locate provided three (3) 1/4-20 x 1" Flat Head Socket Cap Screws. Align the Backer Plate mounting holes with the Breather Manifold. Insert the screws into the mounting holes of the Backer Plate and fasten it to the manifold. Fully tighten hardware.

TORQUE VALUE FOR BACKPLATE SCREWS: 40-60 IN-LBS (4.5-6.8 NM)

**STEP 19** 

Refer to PIC 18 and 19. Locate the Air Filter and two (2) Button Head Cap Screws and (2) Washers that were removed in Step 17. Place the washers onto the screws. Apply a small amount of blue Loctite to screws. Align the air filter mounting holes with the Backer Plate stand offs. Fasten the Air Filter to the Backer Plate by using the screw and washer combos. Fully tighten hardware.





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**STEP 20** 

Refer to PIC 20 and 21. Locate the Cover. Be aware that there is a tab located on the left back side of the cover that will align with a notch on the left back side of the backer plate.


**STEP 21** 

Refer to PIC 22. Slide the cover over the air filter assembly starting from the back side of the bike and pushing it towards the front of the bike. Be sure the tab of the cover is seated properly in the notch of the backer plate. Push the cover forward. There should be a little gap between the cover and the cone of the assembly.



**STEP 22** 

Refer to PIC 23 and 24. Locate the two (2) socket head cap screws that were removed in Step 17. Apply a small amount of blue Loctite to screws. Insert the screws into the outside edge holes of the cone. As you tighten the screws the cover should pull forward, closing the gap between the cone and cover. Fully tighten all four (4) screws in the cone.



**STEP 23** 

Refer to PIC 25. Connect the Hypercharger's servo motor connector with the controller's 3-pin connector. Use the provided 6" cable ties to fasten the controller's wires to other secure cables or the frame of the bike to secure the wires out of the way.

**STEP 24** 

Reinstall main fuse. Turn ignition on and test newly installed Hypercharger ES air cleaner. Turn ignition off.

**STEP 25** 

Reinstall left cover, and the seat if applicable.
