# Harley-Davidson® FL Touring 1997-2017

Passenger Seat

**Hardware:** Stock 1/4" -20 Rear fender Screw

Black nylon washer (included if needed)

Slotted mounting nuts/bolts x 2 (Mustang part 78028 for

1997-1998 or 78032 for 1999-up—**not included**)

**Tools needed:** Phillips screwdriver

#### **Mounting of Mustang seat:**

- 1. CVO models: Remove any plastic trim from the fender so the Mustang passenger seat installs on the bare fender.
- 2. The two notches at the front of the baseplate engage the slotted bolts or nuts mounting the solo seat.
- 3. For seats without a built-in passenger backrest, place the black nylon washer between the fender and rear bracket, and secure with stock 1/4"-20 x 1/2" screw. Seats with a built-in passenger bracket have a stepped bracket and do not require a washer.

## Passenger Backrest (if applicable):

- 1. The passenger backrest can be set forward or back with the  $^5/_{16}$ "-24 x  $^3/_4$ " adjustment screw.
- 2. The height of the passenger backrest can be set by tightening the rear knob to engage one of the notches on the post.
