
Route 1 Road Trip Saddlebags Mounting Instructions


Please read instructions carefully before installation. We recommend this product be installed by a qualified, and experienced technician. If you are unsure of any of the below directions and or your ability to correctly and securely install this product, please contact us or your local dealer for help. Below diagrams show typical installation, your vehicle may be different so please use diagrams as a guide. Make sure your vehicle is clean and free from dirt, road grime etc. where the this product mounts. It is the riders responsibility to make sure the product is mounted and secure before each use. Loading the bag may result in a change of position, always check for proper mounting position after loading and before each and every ride.

Before beginning installation, make sure motorcycle is on level ground. For motorcycle models with a pillion seat, remove the seat and clean the rear fender and strut mounting area. Bags are side specific so the UltraMax logo will face the rear of the motorcycle. Locate the strut bolts on either side of the motorcycle and remove one bolt at a time. After removing a bolt, select the appropriate washer to use in conjunction with your strut. Two options have been provided for the most popular models of fitment.


Take one of the brackets provided with your saddlebags and attach to your motorcycles strut. Repeat with the remaining strut bolts one at a time. Do not over tighten, refer to your owner's manual for the correct torque specs.




Once both saddlebags are attached, you can now adjust the self-fastening yoke to the desired width of your motorcycle fender. Reattach the seat and confirm the bags are secure.



Starting with one bag, zip open and place one hand behind a bracket for support and push from the inside of the saddlebag to clip into the strut bracket "C" clip firmly. Once attached, the bag can be adjusted side to side for optimal placement.



Included rain covers are labeled "Left" and "Right" on the inside. Starting with the bottom of the rain cover, unhook the lower self-fastening strap and slide the elastic band through and reattach straps.



To install the top elastic band, detach yoke by unzipping. Slide the elastic band around the zipper and reattach yoke. Pull the barrel clasp on the top of the rain cover to secure.


