

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS – Rear Passenger Side

NOTE: Reference illustration for holes and panels. The assembly is in alpha-numeric order.


- 1. Secure vehicle!
- 2. Holding panel A in place, making sure the outer edge of the fender aligns with the raised edge of the fender flare. Mark and drill hole A1 and A2 using a 1/4" drill bit. Insert a pan head screw and flange nut and lightly tighten! (See Photo 1)
- 3. Holding panel B in place, making sure the edge of the fender lines up with the raised edge of the fender flare. Mark and drill hole B1 using a 1/4" drill bit. Insert a pan head screw and flange nut and lightly tighten! (See Photo 2)
- 4. Hold panel B in place, making sure the edge of the fender matches up with the raised edge of the fender flare. Mark and drill hole B2 and B3 using a ¼" drill bit. Insert a pan head screw and flange nut and lightly tighten! (See Photo 3)
- 5. Holding panel C in place, making sure the edge of the fender lines up with the raised edge of the fender flare. Mark and drill hole C1 using a ¼" drill bit. Insert a pan head screw and flange nut and lightly tighten! (See Photo 4)
- 6. Holding panel C in place, making sure the edge of the fender lines up with the raised edge of the fender flare. Mark and drill hole C2, C3, and C4 using a 1/4" drill bit. Insert a pan head screw and flange nut into each and lightly tighten!
- 7. Holding panel D in place, making sure the edge of the fender lines up with the raised edge of the fender flare. Mark and drill hole D1 using a 1/4" drill bit. Insert a pan head screw and flange nut and tighten lightly. (See Photo 4)
- 8. Make sure all edges are lined up correctly and tighten all fasteners.
- 9. Repeat these instructions for the opposite side.
