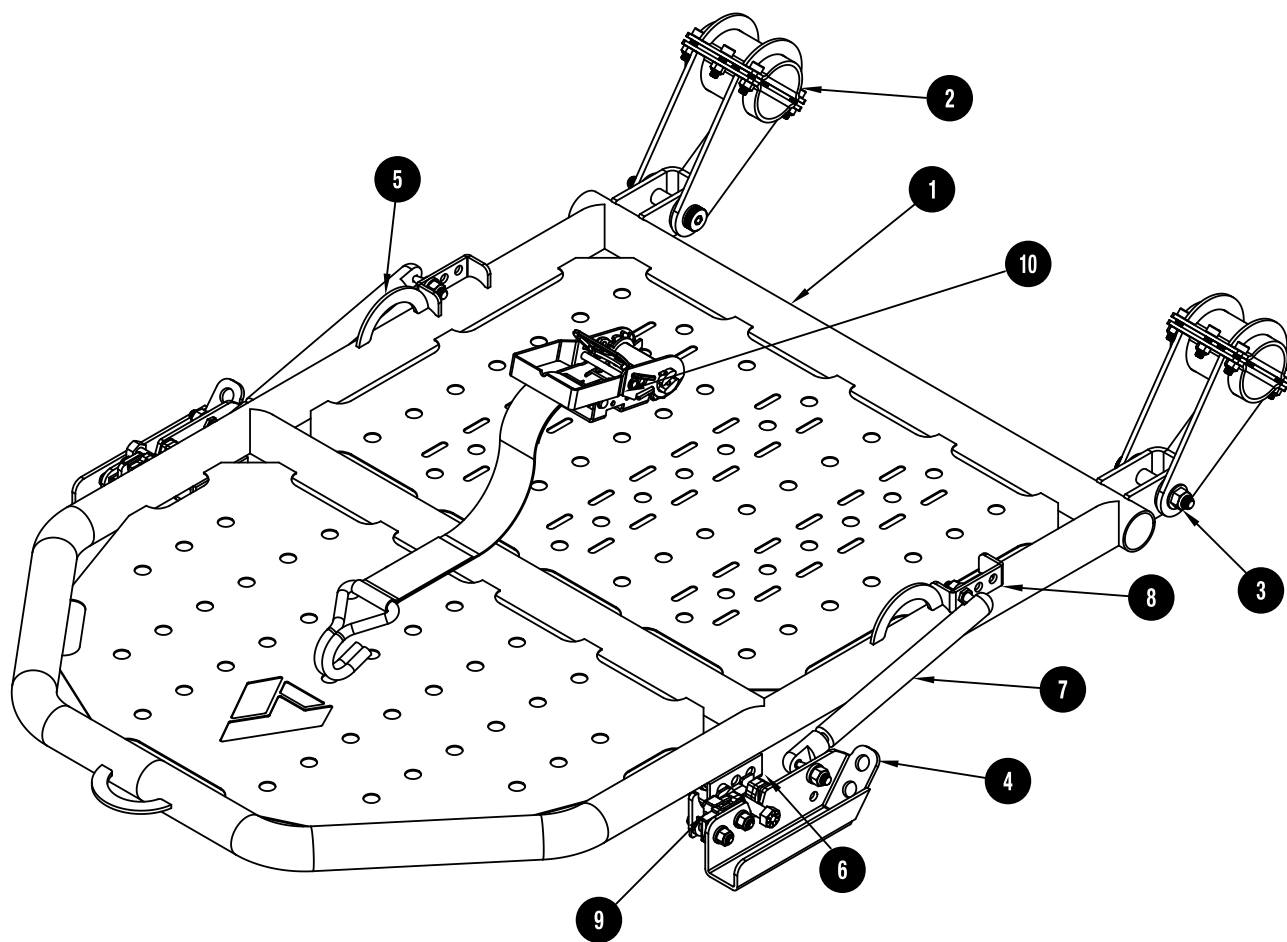

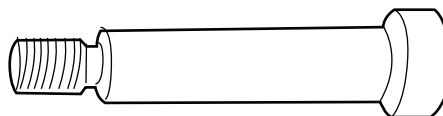

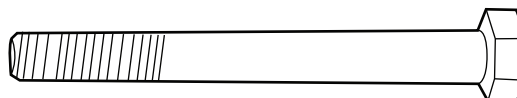

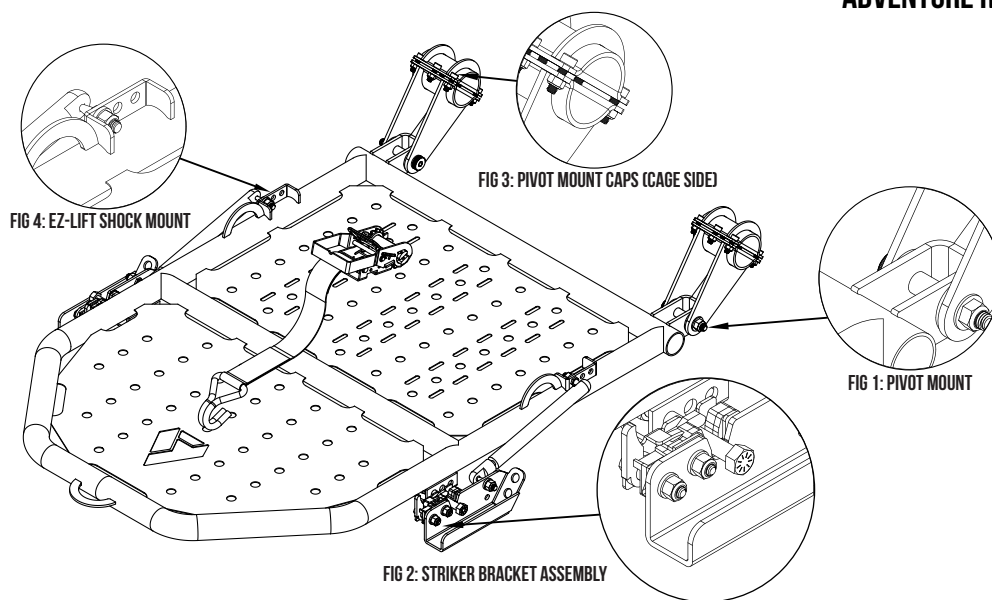

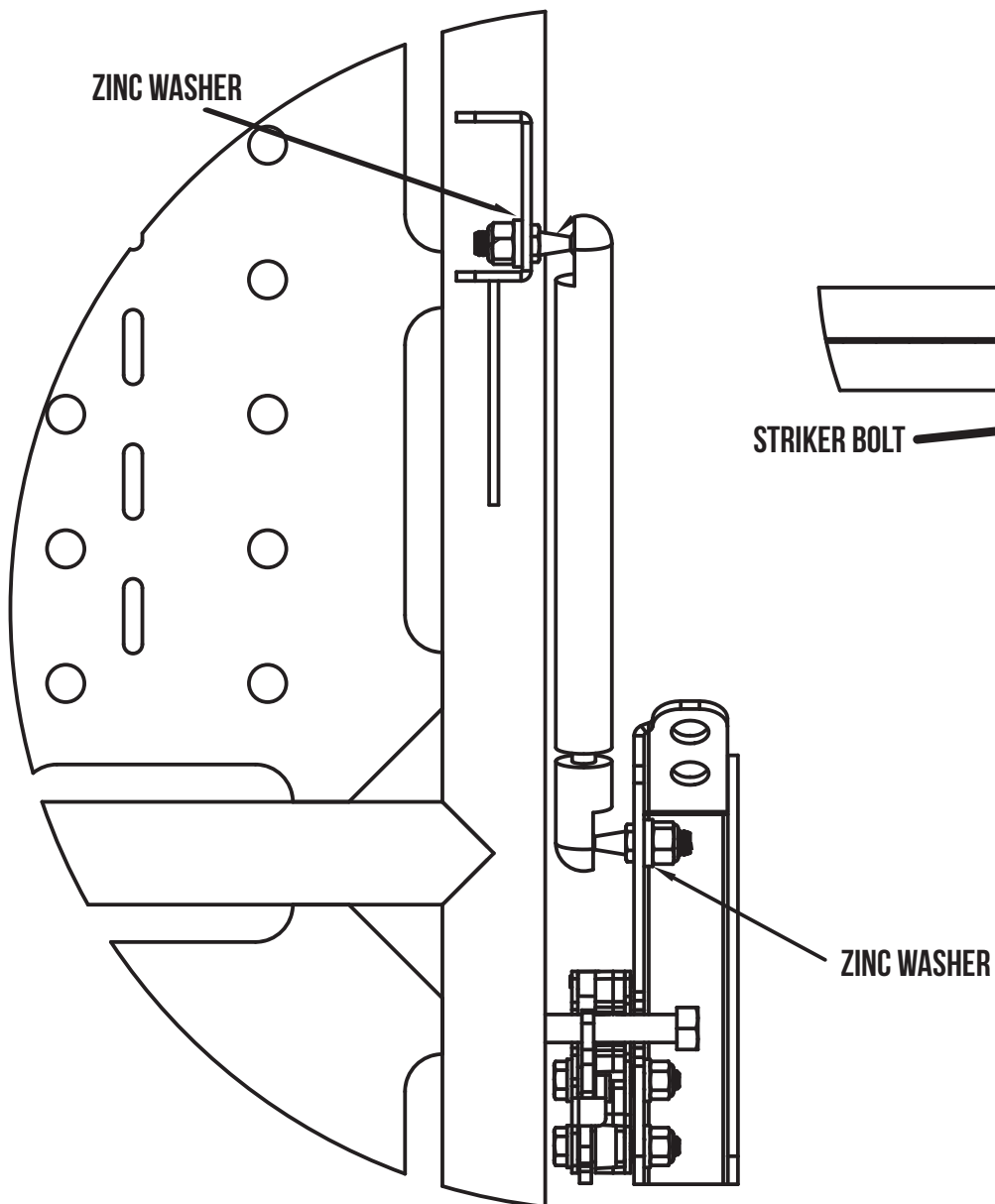
INSTALLATION

1. Set the Adventure Rack on a flat surface and begin installing the rack pivot mount, using the supplied plastic washers. (Fig. 1) The washers should be placed on the inside where between the pivot mount and rack. This step requires 2 shoulder screws with 6mm hex cap and 15mm nylon lock nut. **Note:** Do not install the EZ-lift ball socket studs in this step.
2. Assemble the striker bracket and latch as pictured in (Fig. 2). The nylon lock nuts should be installed facing out. This step requires a 4mm hex key and 11mm wrench or socket. **Note:** Do not install the EZ-lift ball socket studs in this step.
3. Place the rack on the cage and attach the pivot caps with nuts and bolts. Finger tighten for now.
4. Remove the 2 rear bolts from the cage on each side and install the striker brackets. This step requires a 15mm wrench or socket. Use a torque wrench to snug bolts to 30ft lbs.
5. Align the rack with the striker bracket at the desired rear height to see where the striker bolt needs to be positioned. Once at the desired position, tighten the pivot mount cap bolts (Fig. 3). A 5mm hex key and 10mm wrench is required for this step. **Note:** A wrench must be used as a socket will not fit on all bolt heads.
6. Install the striker bolt in the position noted in step 4 on each side of the rack. Test fit the striker into the latch before tightening completely. This step requires a 14mm and 15mm wrench and/or socket.
7. Install the EZ lift gas shock ball socket studs (Fig. 2) on the striker bracket and rack. Mount position can be adjusted forward or backward on the rack for desired height. Thread locker can be used on this step.
8. Double check all bolts for proper tightness. Test latches to ensure proper release. If everything is working correctly, your adventure rack is ready to use!

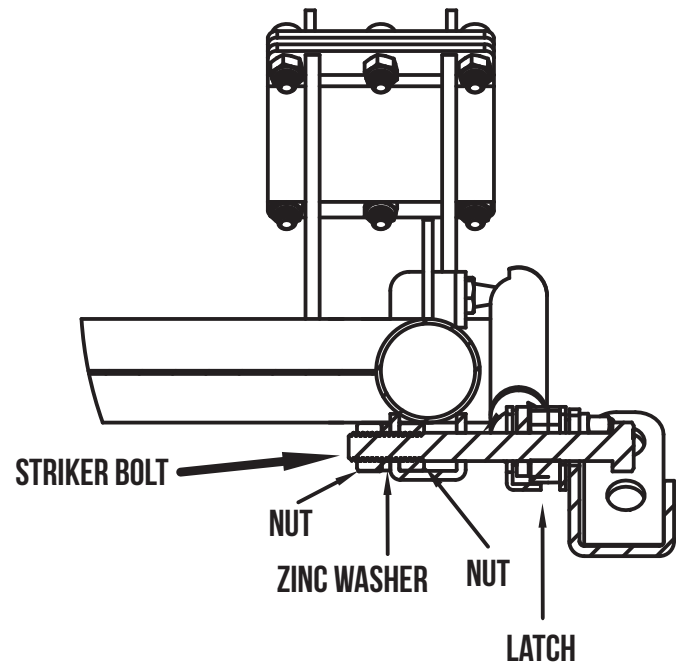
Note: The EZ lift shocks are meant to assist in raising the rack. With weight it may not lift on its own, but should stay up when extended fully.
