






## STOCK LICENSE PLATE REMOVAL & VANCE & HINES INSTALLATION

- 1. Remove the seat with ignition key.
- 2. Disconnect the wiring shown in Figure 1.
- **3.** Unfasten the 4 bolts showin in Figure 2.
- 4. Carefully remove the OEM fender assembly and wiring from the motorcycle.
- 5. On the OEM fender, unfasten all the screws shown in Figure 3 and 4.
- 6. Remove the (2) screws shown in Figure 5, and the (1) bolt shown in Figure 6.
- 7. Remove the screws shown in Figure 7, this will free the license plate light assembly.
- 8. Remove the nuts showin in Figure 8, and remove the license plate light from the assembly.
- 9. Disconnect the turn signal connectors show in Figure 9.
- **10.** Remove the OEM flange nuts shown in Figure 10, then remove the turn signal, keep the flange nuts as these will be reused for assembly of Vance & Hines' Fender Eliminator.
- 11. Run the wiring of the OEM turn signals through the V&H Fender Eliminatory as shown in Figure 11, be sure to check that the screw on the turn signal is facing down and it clocks into the slot cutout, fasten with OEM flange nut do this for both sides.
- 12. Run wiring for OEM license plate light as shown in Figure 12.
- **13.** Fasten license plate light with the two M5 hex nuts (Item 3) and washer (Item5) as shown in Figure 13, leave loose at this time.
- **14.** Reconnect the turn light wiring as shown in Figure 14, be sure to match the coloring of the wiring when connecting.
- 15. Run the wiring through the frame's square cutout as shown in Figure 15.
- 16. Install the bolts (Item 4) and fasten with nuts (Item 6) as shown in Figure 16.
- 17. Run the wiring as it was before, underneath the gaps between fender mounts. Then connect the ends as shown in Figure 1.
- 18. Install frame using 5/16-18 screw (Item 4), 5/16 washer (Item 7) and 5/16-18 nut (Item 6)
- **19.** Secure wiring using cutouts on frame and supplied ziptie (Item 10)
- 20. Install V&H Cover (Item 2) using 1/4-20 screw (Item 8), and 1/4-20 nut (Item 9). Adjust license plate cover to leave clearance between the cover and the light. Tighten nuts.
- **21.** Be sure to tighten all the hardware before starting your motorcycle.
- **22.** Check to see that all the lights are working correctly.
