

How to adjust Footpeg positions






- -1) Decide which mounting hole on bracket to use. The top holes are a lower footpeg position - closer to stock footpeg height.
- 2) Decide which mounting hole in pocket to use.






- 3) Position #1 at 12 o'clock position for shift and brake. Be sure other numbers are not upside down.
- 4) Tab reader will indicate which position you are on. **CAUTION** - Each number has two positions. Be sure to use the same position for shift and brake side.
